ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF
SECOND DISTRIBUTION OF
SETTLEMENT AWARDS

BEFORE THE COURT is Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion to Approve Second
Distribution of Settlement Awards. ECF No. 424. The Court has reviewed the
record and files herein, and is fully informed. The time for opposing this motion

1 has now passed, LCivR 7(c)(2), with no opposition filed. There being no reason
2 for further delay, the Court enters this Order.

3 The Court retained jurisdiction over the implementation, enforcement and
4 administration of the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement.
5 ECF No. 412 at 34. The Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action
6 Settlement authorized a second distribution of unclaimed funds, if administratively
7 feasible. *Id.* at 32-33. The Court finds that distribution of the unclaimed funds is
8 administratively feasible before the remainder is distributed to the *cy pres*
9 recipients. The only additional authorization Plaintiff seeks is permission to pay
10 unanticipated fees of up to \$13,258.00 to the Class Administrator for processing
11 the second distribution. For good cause shown, Plaintiffs' motion is **GRANTED**.

12 **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED:**

13 1. Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion to Approve Second Distribution of
14 Settlement Awards, ECF No. 424, is **GRANTED**.

15 2. A second distribution of settlement proceeds is approved to occur as
16 soon as practical after entry of this Order. In accordance with the Order Granting
17 Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, ECF No. 412 at 32-33, the formula for
18 calculating the pro rata share for the second distribution will be: $URF \times$
19 $CMP/TCCMP$, where URF is the amount of unclaimed remaining settlement
20 funds, CMP is the amount paid to the Settlement Class member in first distribution,

1 and TCCMP is the total amount paid all Settlement Class Members in the first
2 distribution less the amount of the unclaimed payments (taking into consideration
3 the amount necessary for payment of the claims processing fees below).

4 3. Within 30 days of the expiration date of the second distribution
5 checks (90 days after check issuance) the Claims Administrator shall distribute to
6 itself, out of the Settlement Fund, payment for processing the second distribution
7 in an amount not to exceed \$13,258.00.

8 4. Thereafter, the Class Administrator shall pay all settlement funds
9 which remain unclaimed after the distributions ordered herein to the *cy pres*
10 recipients: 50% to the Northwest Justice Project and 50% to Parkview Services.

11 5. Within 30 days after completing all payments, the Class Administrator
12 shall file with the Court a declaration attesting to its compliance with the
13 provisions of this Order and a final accounting for the distribution of the
14 Settlement Fund.

15 The District Court Executive is directed to enter this Order and provide
16 copies to counsel of record.
